| | Nature Walk (<i>Katelyn</i>) We will all head outside to take a nature walk around the college (near the treeline) looking for interesting rocks. Each child will choose one rock along the way. The rock must be smaller than his/her hand. She/he will not know what the rock is for until coming back inside and better examining the rock. They will get to paint their rock afterward. | Sue is here for vermaculture activities. Vegetable Tasting (<i>Robin</i>) Five vegetables will be cut into sample sizes for tasting. Children rank them after eating. | Scavenger Hunt (<i>Robin</i>) Using images and Ojibwa language, children will search for items within the library in three teams. Drawing (<i>Katelyn</i>) Of your favorite animal that lives underground. | Slug/Frog Tag (<i>Katelyn</i>) This is the same as cat/mouse tag, just renamed. We will be outside standing in a large circle formation. Children stand in pairs with arms linked. The frog chases the slug, they must stay within the circle, the slug can link arms and the person opposite must then run. | Animal Races – worm, rabbit, frog, bear (<i>Katelyn</i>) Two lines will be marked as start and finish, students will race in groups of four first as worms, then rabbits, then frogs, then bears.
